68 HOW CAN I MAKE A REFERRAL?

Getting started with school-based counseling services is easy. Parents, caregivers, or school staff can start the referral process by speaking with any member of the school's guidance staff. The guidance counselors will help the family complete our simple, confidential referral form. We verify the child's insurance information and then call the caregivers to schedule the child's first session at school.

WHAT IF MY CHILD NEEDS MORE HELP?

Child Guidance offers 24 different services to meet a wide variety of mental and behavioral health needs. Psychological and psychiatric assessments are available to determine additional options. From groups, case management, and family programs to medication management, with the help of your school-based counselor we will determine the best course of treatment to guide your child to a healthy, fulfilling life.
