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## What Are Extended Assessment Services [EAS]?

Choosing the right solution for your child's challenges depends on a structured, thorough approach to assessing your child's specific needs. At Child Guidance Resource Centers, we have refined the assessment process over 55 years to ensure your child gets the right therapy as quickly as possible.

The EAS process takes an in-depth look at your child in all his/her surroundings – home, school and community. We can then identify the most appropriate services for addressing your child's needs, whether they be emotional, behavioral, developmental, or on the Autism Spectrum.

Parents, teachers, social workers, guardians, guidance counselors, and mental health workers typically refer families to EAS, but anyone can make a referral, provided the child's insurance information is available during the first call and at least one caregiver is willing to participate in the 60-day process.
